### Collage Boxes

#### Materials

- Box of any size
- Recycled materials such as cardboard, packing materials, plastic, egg cartons, bottle caps, etc.
- Scissors
- Glue or tape
- Drawing materials such as crayons, markers, or colored pencils



#### Instructions

- Arrange objects inside your box, thinking about combining different materials to create new shapes and textures. Fold, bend, cut, and shape your materials to create layers.
- Use glue or tape to attach your objects to each other and to your box.
- Use drawing materials to add additional details like color or designs.
- If you would like, create additional collage boxes and combine them together to create a larger work of art.
