#### Scratch Art

### Materials

- Sturdy, light-colored paper
- Crayons or oil pastels
- Black or dark paint, either store-bought or homemade (see instructions)
- Paintbrush or sponge
- Cotton swabs and toothpicks

#### Instructions

- With your crayons or oil pastels, cover your entire paper with colorful lines, shapes, and designs.
- Once you finish drawing colors on the page, cover your entire drawing with dark paint using a paintbrush or sponge. (To create homemade dark paint, combine 1 tablespoon of flour, 1 tablespoon of salt, and 1–2 tablespoons of water to achieve the right consistency to make the base for your paint. Add a combination of different food coloring to create a dark color, adjusting the amount of each color as needed. Mix to combine.)
- While the paint is still wet, drag a cotton swab across the page to reveal the colors below. When the painting dries, use a toothpick to add more designs by scratching the surface to reveal the colors below. Create your dream scene using one or both of these techniques.
